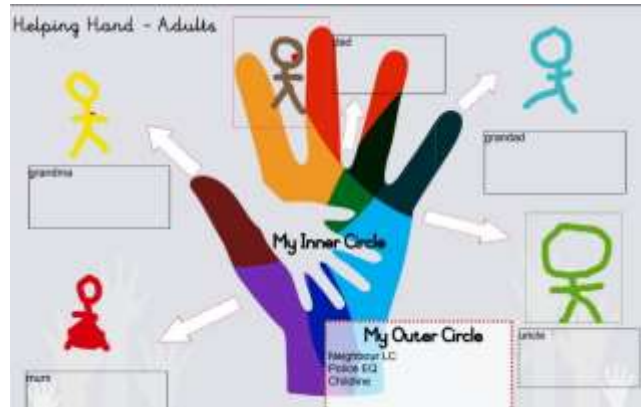
Ladies Night

Moment of Mindfulness:

Next Tuesday is Shrove Tuesday, traditionally the last chance for a feast before Ash Wednesday starts Lent. Traditionally Christians would eat less food or fast for the days up to Easter. This helped them to focus on God and not the things they wanted. Sunday however is still a celebration day with no fasting.

During Lent it is also usual for Christians to pray or read the Bible every day. This is in recognition of Jesus' journey of 40 days in the desert to be alone with God. By praying and reading the Bible Christians aim to feel closer to God.

There are lots of ways to participate in Lent, you may wish to increase your devotion to God, or give something up such as sweets, or try to live more simply.
