Our story for our final two weeks is: The Three Little Pigs

Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE)	Over the next two weeks the children will be supported to consider the characters in the story and think about their feelings. This will support children to recognise the feelings of their friends and explore different points of view.
Physical Development (PD)	The children will be making Easter cupcakes and considering good hygiene and being safe when using the equipment. This will continue on after science week from our discussion about washing our hands correctly.
Communication & Language (CL)	During circle time the children will be learning about the Easter story and we will be touching on the importance of Easter and the real meaning behind it.
Literacy (LD)	The children will have the opportunity to share stories and have a go at retelling them independently. The children will have a go at finishing off key sentences and describing what is happening in the pictures.
Mathematical Development (MD)	The children will be able to build models using shapes and construction resources and thinking about the positioning of them to build the best 'three little pigs' house. The children's mathematical language will be enhanced by using positional language e.g. behind, in front, next to etc.
Understanding the World (UW)	During forest school the children will be able to build their own dens and we will be thinking about materials that we can construct with. The children can reflect on past experiences where they may have been in a tent, motorhome, or another type of den.
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	Finally, the children will be making their own Easter gift in the workshop area to reinforce the true meaning of Easter. Also, throughout their own play staff will enhance children's language and model appropriate behaviour which will be developed through their small world play using the three little pig's story line.
